Dear Chawner Hurd,

Thank you for giving me and the Button Hole Golf Course and Teaching Center the opportunity to try your Organic Gem Liquid Fish Fertilizer.

I experimented on several areas of the golf course, greens, practice greens, target greens and my north driving range tee. The north driving range tee was my main focus. My plans were to apply Organic Gem only, no other fertilizers or fungicides, and see the results. Although I applied herbicides and insect control, the tee held up nicely all year, giving a nice lime green color throughout the season. No applications of fungicides were applied with no ill effects. I also noticed the wilt stress was not as severe in the areas of inadequate water.

When I applied it to the 2<sup>nd</sup> green I noticed nice greening, but again the wilting areas were greening up again and the tolerance to the heat was greater.

The target green on the driving range was water starved, and under stress from the range cart travel. The green was bentgrass sown on top of compacted soils. After applying Organic Gem Fish Fertilizer, the green started resisting the wilt conditions and regaining its color and growth.

In conclusion, I find that the Organic Gem is not just a great (organic) fertilizer, but it has some wetting agents similarities.

Thank you again for sharing your product, and I look forward to using your product in the 2003 season.
